ORDER FOR RELIEF

The above-captioned Chapter 9 case was filed by Connector 2000 Association, Inc. (“Debtor”) on June 24, 2010. Pursuant to the Order entered upon commencement of the case on June 25, 2010 and amended June 28, 2010 (“Commencement Order”), if no objection to Debtor’s chapter 9 petition was filed, the Commencement Order would serve as notice of entry of an order for relief under Chapter 9. An objection to the Debtor’s Chapter 9 petition was filed by The South Carolina Department of Transportation (“SCDOT”), and therefore no order for relief has previously been entered. SCDOT’s objection was withdrawn by an Order entered December 16, 2010. Accordingly, the Court hereby enters this Order for Relief granting Debtor relief under Chapter 9 of the Bankruptcy Code subject only to terms of the Court’s Order entered on December 16, 2010, and the reservation of rights set forth therein in favor of SCDOT.

IT IS ORDERED that Debtor shall publish this order giving notice of the entry of the order for relief in the *The Bond Buyer*, *The State*, and *The Greenville News*, as required by 11 U.S.C. § 923. Proof of Publication shall be filed with the Court not later than ten (10) days after the last publication.
